1. Executive Summary

\$GARY — The Gary Sinise Foundation Token — is a community-driven cryptocurrency on the Solana blockchain, created as a tribute to American veterans, active military, first responders, and the families who stand behind them. The project's central purpose is to channel speculative trading activity into measurable, verifiable charitable impact.

Through the donation infrastructure of Pump.Fun and donate.gg, ninety-nine percent (99%) of trading fees generated by the \$GARY token are routed directly to the publicly listed donation address of the Gary Sinise Foundation. The remaining one percent (1%) is reserved for the operational sustainability of the community project: marketing, content production, community management, hosting, and the operational costs of growing this initiative responsibly.

The community behind \$GARY is unaffiliated with the Foundation. We are not employees, partners, or representatives of the Foundation, and nothing in this document or in our public communications should be interpreted as suggesting otherwise. Our relationship to the Foundation is the same as any anonymous donor's: we contribute funds to a publicly listed address that the Foundation may choose to accept or decline.

In one sentence

\$GARY is a community-built tribute token that converts 99% of its trading fees into transparent, on-chain donations to the Gary Sinise Foundation, with no claim of affiliation and no expectation of formal endorsement.

2. The Mission

Cryptocurrency trading produces an enormous amount of velocity — buys, sells, and fees flowing through automated market makers every second of every day. Most of that velocity benefits no one but a handful of insiders. \$GARY exists to redirect a meaningful share of that velocity toward people whose service makes our way of life possible.

Our three commitments

- **Honor.** Every fee, every block, every trade — a small salute to those who carried the weight so we wouldn't have to.
- **Transparency.** Donation flows are governed by Pump.Fun's published mechanics. Totals are publicly tracked on donate.gg. Every dollar's path is verifiable on-chain.
- **Community.** No insiders. No private allocations. No team tokens. A community of holders, posters, and patriots organized around a shared purpose.

Why this token, why now

Charitable giving in crypto has a credibility problem. Many "charity tokens" raise large treasuries and never deliver. Others promise donations contingent on hitting market cap milestones that never arrive. \$GARY's design solves this problem at the protocol level: donations are not promised, voted on, or contingent. They happen automatically, on every trade, through infrastructure built by Pump.Fun specifically for this purpose.

This means the project does not need to be trusted. The mechanism is the trust.

3. About the Beneficiary: The Gary Sinise Foundation

Educational Section — Public Information Only

The information below is summarized from publicly available sources, including the Gary Sinise Foundation's official website and publicly filed materials. It is provided so prospective \$GARY participants understand who the donation beneficiary is. It does not constitute or imply any endorsement, partnership, or relationship between the \$GARY community and the Foundation.

Founded in 2011 by actor Gary Sinise — known to many for his portrayal of "Lt. Dan" in Forrest Gump and his decades of personal advocacy for U.S. veterans — the Gary Sinise Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to serving America's defenders, veterans, first responders, their families, and those in need. The Foundation's stated motto is "Serving Honor and Need."

The Foundation's programs

Based on publicly available information, the Foundation operates a number of distinct programs. A non-exhaustive overview:

- **R.I.S.E. (Restoring Independence Supporting Empowerment)** — Building specially adapted, mortgage-free smart homes for the most severely wounded post-9/11 veterans, including those with quadriplegia, amputations, blindness, or severe burn injuries.
- **Snowball Express** — A program providing year-round support, mentorship, and an annual gathering for the children of fallen U.S. military heroes.
- **Serving Heroes** — Providing meals, gratitude visits, and morale events for service members, first responders, and their families across the country.
- **Relief & Resiliency Outreach** — Direct emergency aid for veterans, first responders, and their families facing hardship, illness, or other crises.
- **Soaring Valor** — Sponsoring travel for World War II veterans to visit memorials and museums dedicated to their service.

Why this beneficiary

The Foundation was selected by the \$GARY community because it represents a verifiable, established, well-regarded organization with a long track record of direct, measurable impact on the populations the community wishes to honor. The Foundation maintains transparent reporting practices and is recognized as a charity by independent watchdogs.

Prospective participants are encouraged to research the Foundation directly at the Foundation's official website and to evaluate its work on its own merits, separate from this token project.

5. Tokenomics

Distribution philosophy

\$GARY launched as a fair-launch token on Pump.Fun. There is no presale, no team allocation, no advisor allocation, and no private round. Every holder acquired their tokens on the open market, paying the same price as everyone else who traded at the same moment.

This is a deliberate design choice. A token whose stated purpose is honoring service should not begin with a small group of insiders enriched at the expense of the community. The community's contribution to the project is its trading volume; that volume is what generates the donation flow.

Community supply commentary

Because \$GARY launched fair, there is no "team wallet" to monitor for dumps and no vesting schedule to enforce. Holders can independently verify supply distribution using any Solana block explorer (e.g., Solscan, Solana Beach). The community encourages this scrutiny.

Some early community members may hold meaningful positions purely as a function of having bought early. This is normal in any fair-launch token and should not be confused with a privileged allocation. No private grants of supply have been made.

6. Fee Structure & Donation Mechanism

How the donation flow actually works

The donation mechanism is not a promise; it is a feature of the underlying platform. Pump.Fun launched a charity feature that allows token creators to designate that a portion of trading fees collected by the platform be routed to a publicly listed donation address managed by donate.gg. donate.gg in turn maintains verified, on-chain donation addresses for established 501(c)(3) charities — including the Gary Sinise Foundation.

In the case of \$GARY:

1. A buyer or seller initiates a swap on the \$GARY market on Pump.Fun (or, post-graduation, on Raydium).
2. The platform automatically collects a small fee on the trade, as it does on every trade across the platform.
3. Of that fee, ninety-nine percent (99%) is automatically routed to the donate.gg-managed donation address for the Gary Sinise Foundation.
4. One percent (1%) is retained by the project for operational sustainability — community management, content, hosting, marketing, and similar costs.
5. The donation total is publicly visible on donate.gg's charity page and verifiable on Solana block explorers. The community does not handle, custody, or distribute any of these funds directly.

What the 1% supports

Operating a community token is not free. The 1% retained by the project is allocated, in rough order of priority, toward:

- Hosting, domain, and infrastructure costs for the official website and any community tools.
- Community management — moderators, content creators, and the time required to maintain healthy Telegram and X presences.
- Content and creative production — graphics, video, copywriting, and educational materials.
- Paid marketing where it serves the donation goal (e.g., promoted posts that drive trading volume, which in turn drives donations).
- Future merchandise development costs (design, prototyping, vendor relationships).
- Legal review when warranted.

The community's stated principle is that the 1% should never be used to enrich any individual. It exists to keep the engine running, not to pay salaries.

What we do NOT do

- We do not handle, hold, or distribute donation funds. The donation flow is automated through Pump.Fun and donate.gg.
- We do not issue tax receipts. Anyone seeking a charitable tax deduction should donate directly to the Foundation through its official channels.
- We do not accept donations into a community wallet. Anyone wishing to donate to the Foundation directly should do so through the Foundation's official site.
- We do not represent the Foundation, accept funds on its behalf, or speak for it in any capacity.

7. Technology Stack

\$GARY is built on widely used, publicly verifiable cryptocurrency infrastructure. No custom contracts were written by the community — the project relies entirely on standard Solana primitives and the Pump.Fun protocol.

Solana

Solana is a high-throughput, low-fee Layer-1 blockchain. It was selected for its negligible transaction costs (typically a fraction of a cent), fast finality, and broad ecosystem support. Solana's economics are well suited to a project that depends on high transaction volume to generate meaningful donations: every trade contributes.

Pump.Fun

Pump.Fun is the launchpad and primary trading venue for the token in its early lifecycle. Pump.Fun's bonding-curve mechanics are well documented and widely used; once a token reaches a market cap threshold, it "graduates" and liquidity is migrated to Raydium for ongoing AMM-style trading.

Crucially for this project, Pump.Fun launched a built-in charity donation feature that allows a portion of platform fees to be designated for charitable beneficiaries through the donate.gg integration. This is the mechanism that makes \$GARY's donation flow possible and trustworthy.

Raydium

After graduation from the Pump.Fun bonding curve, \$GARY trades on Raydium, Solana's leading automated market maker. Raydium uses concentrated and constant-product liquidity pool models that are battle-tested across many high-volume Solana tokens.

donate.gg

donate.gg is a Pump.Fun-affiliated platform that maintains verified donation addresses for established charitable organizations. It serves as the public ledger for tracking \$GARY-generated donations to the Gary Sinise Foundation. The running total is published in real time on the Foundation's donate.gg charity page.

What this means for the community

Because every component of the stack is public, third-party-operated, and verifiable, no party in the \$GARY community can unilaterally redirect, withhold, or skim donations. The flow is enforced at the platform level. This is the strongest possible architecture for a charity-flow token: trust is replaced with code.

8. Roadmap

The roadmap below describes the community's current ambitions in good faith. None of the items beyond Phase 1 represent guarantees, commitments, or contractual promises. Plans evolve based on community input, market conditions, regulatory developments, and — critically — the voluntary participation of any third parties named (most importantly, the Foundation itself, whose engagement cannot be assumed).

Phase 1 — Foundation (Active)

- Token launched on Pump.Fun with the 99% / 1% fee split active and verifiable.
- Official website published at garysft.netlify.app, including donation flow explanation, contract address verification, and a live link to the Gary Sinise Foundation page on donate.gg.
- Official X (formerly Twitter) account active at [@GARYSINISETOKEN](https://twitter.com/GARYSINISETOKEN).
- Community Telegram channel active and moderated.
- Whitepaper (this document) published.
- Community-driven posting and engagement to drive trading volume — and therefore donations.

Phase 2 — Community Growth

- Expanded community programming: regular spaces on X, AMAs, community contests, and recognition of high-contribution community members.
- Educational content about the Foundation's programs — written and produced independently by the community, using publicly available information from the Foundation's official channels.
- Improved tooling: live donation counters, automated milestone announcements, on-chain transparency dashboards.
- Coordinated community days tied to relevant national observances (Memorial Day, Veterans Day, Independence Day, 9/11 commemorations, First Responder appreciation days), where the community organizes posting and awareness pushes.
- Continued Raydium liquidity health and trading volume initiatives.

Phase 3 — Merchandise & Memorabilia (Aspirational)

As the community grows, members have expressed interest in developing community-produced merchandise — apparel, hats, patches, challenge coins, prints, and similar memorabilia — that celebrates the project's themes of honor, sacrifice, and service.

Any merchandise produced under the \$GARY community brand will adhere to the following principles:

- Will not use the Gary Sinise Foundation's name, logo, trademarks, or any other indicia of the Foundation without the Foundation's express written permission.
- Will be clearly marked as community-produced and unaffiliated with the Foundation.
- Will use original artwork and trademarks owned by the community.
- Where reasonable, a portion of merchandise proceeds may be directed to additional donations to the Foundation through the same donate.gg infrastructure — but any such commitment will be specifically disclosed at the time of sale.
- Pricing, fulfillment, and operations will be conducted through standard e-commerce vendors with separate accounting from the on-chain donation flow.

Phase 4 — Aspirational Engagement with the Foundation

Aspirational Only — No Engagement Currently Exists

The community's long-term aspiration is that, as the cumulative donation total to the Gary Sinise Foundation grows to a meaningful level and the community demonstrates good faith and good conduct over time, the Foundation may at its sole discretion choose to acknowledge, accept, or even formally engage with the community.

Critically: as of the publication date of this whitepaper, no such engagement exists. The community has not entered into any agreement, conversation, or arrangement with the Foundation. We have no contact, no introduction, no understanding of any kind. We are donors and admirers, nothing more.

Any future engagement is entirely at the Foundation's option. The Foundation owes the community nothing, and the community will respect any decision the Foundation makes — including a decision to decline donations or distance itself from this project. The success of \$GARY does not depend on Foundation engagement; the donation mechanism functions regardless.

Examples of the kind of engagement the community would welcome at the Foundation's discretion include: official acknowledgment of donations received; participation in awareness events; cooperative content; or co-branded charitable initiatives. Each of these would require the Foundation's voluntary assent and would be conducted strictly under terms the Foundation finds acceptable. None of these are promised, planned, or in negotiation as of this writing.

Phase 5 — Long-term Sustainability

- Establish a sustainable, low-overhead operating model that does not depend on any single contributor.
- Continue ratcheting cumulative donations year over year while preserving the project's no-affiliation, no-promises posture toward the Foundation.
- Document and publish annual community reports — covering total donations facilitated, community growth, content produced, and lessons learned.

- Where appropriate and the community supports it, expand the donation infrastructure to support additional aligned charitable causes (e.g., other veteran or first-responder organizations) as a complement to the primary Foundation flow — never as a replacement.

9. Community

\$GARY is, before anything else, a community. The token is the mechanism; the community is the engine. There is no centralized team, no investor base, and no off-chain governance structure. Decisions about marketing direction, content production, merchandise design, and event participation emerge from rough consensus among active participants on X and Telegram.

Community standards

Participation in the \$GARY community is open to anyone aligned with the project's values. The community asks members to uphold a few simple standards:

- Treat fellow community members — and the populations the project honors — with respect.
- Do not impersonate the Foundation, Mr. Sinise, or any other person or entity.
- Always include a clear non-affiliation disclaimer when speaking about the project in public, especially when the Foundation is named.
- Verify the contract address before sharing it. Report scams and impersonators.
- Do not give financial advice. Do not promise price outcomes. Do not pressure others to buy.
- Honor first. Hype second.

10. Risk Factors

Cryptocurrency is a high-risk asset class. \$GARY in particular is a community-driven token without traditional investor protections. Prospective participants should carefully consider the following risks before purchasing or holding any \$GARY tokens. This is not an exhaustive list.

Market risk

\$GARY's price is determined entirely by open-market trading. The price can — and likely will — be highly volatile. Substantial losses, including total loss, are possible. There is no price floor and no buyer of last resort.

Liquidity risk

The trading liquidity available for \$GARY is a function of community participation. Liquidity may decline at any time, making it difficult or impossible to sell at any meaningful price. Slippage and price impact may be severe on larger trades.

Platform risk

The donation mechanism depends on the continued operation, integrity, and policy choices of Pump.Fun, donate.gg, Raydium, and the Solana network. If any of these platforms changes its policies, suffers an outage, is exploited, or ceases to operate, the donation flow may be interrupted, modified, or terminated. The community has no control over any of these third parties.

Smart contract risk

Even though no custom contracts were written for \$GARY, the project depends on a stack of smart contracts (Pump.Fun, Raydium, SPL Token program, donate.gg routing). Smart contracts can contain bugs, can be exploited, or can be subject to governance decisions outside the community's control.

Regulatory risk

Cryptocurrency regulation is evolving and varies dramatically by jurisdiction. Future regulation may affect the token's tradability, the project's ability to operate, or the legal status of its participants. The Foundation may be regulated or advised in a manner that requires it to decline donations from sources like this project.

Beneficiary risk

The Gary Sinise Foundation has no obligation to accept donations from this project, no obligation to acknowledge them, and no obligation to maintain its presence on donate.gg. The Foundation could at any time request that the project cease using its name, decline donations routed via donate.gg, or take other action that affects this project. The community will respect any such

decision; participants should understand that the project's relationship to the Foundation is entirely one-directional.

Reputational risk

The community cannot fully control how members or third parties speak about the project. Bad actors may impersonate the project, use its branding inappropriately, or otherwise create reputational harm. Such conduct could affect the project's standing — and, more importantly, could be unfair to the Foundation. Community members are encouraged to actively report and disavow such conduct.

Loss of key contributors

The project has no formal team and no employment relationships. Key contributors may step away at any time. There is no guarantee that the project's content production, community management, or website will continue indefinitely. The donation mechanism, however, will continue regardless of contributor activity, because it is enforced at the protocol level.

Tax risk

Cryptocurrency taxation is complex and varies by jurisdiction. Trading \$GARY may have tax implications. The fact that fees from \$GARY trading are donated to a charity does not entitle the trader to a tax deduction; only direct donations to the Foundation through its own official channels generate a charitable tax receipt. Participants should consult a qualified tax professional.

Total loss is possible

Most cryptocurrencies, including most charity-themed tokens, end up worth substantially less than their peak — often near zero. Participants should never commit funds they cannot afford to lose entirely. \$GARY is not an investment vehicle, not a savings instrument, and not a substitute for direct charitable giving.

11. Legal & Regulatory

Not a security

\$GARY is a community-launched, fair-launch utility/community token. The community asserts that \$GARY is not a security under U.S. or other applicable law: there was no investment of money in a common enterprise with the expectation of profit derived from the efforts of others, in the sense contemplated by the Howey test. There is no team, no managerial effort being sold, no profit-sharing mechanism, and no promise of returns. Trading the token does not entitle any holder to dividends, governance rights, equity, or any other security-like interest.

This characterization is the community's good-faith view. Participants are responsible for understanding the legal status of the token in their own jurisdictions and seeking independent legal advice as needed.

Not investment advice

Nothing in this whitepaper, on the project's website, in its social media channels, or in any community member's statements constitutes investment advice, financial advice, legal advice, or tax advice. All decisions to acquire, hold, or dispose of \$GARY are the sole responsibility of the participant.

Trademark and likeness

The community uses the name "Gary Sinise Foundation" solely as a factual reference to the donation beneficiary, in a manner the community believes constitutes nominative fair use. The community does not use the Foundation's logo, trademarks, slogans (including "Serving Honor and Need"), or other proprietary marks in its branding. The community does not use the likeness, name, or persona of Mr. Gary Sinise in its branding.

If the Foundation or any rights holder believes any community use exceeds fair use or otherwise infringes their rights, please contact the project through the channels listed in the Resources section. The community commits to good-faith and prompt remediation of any reasonable objection.

Geographic restrictions

Participation in \$GARY may be restricted or prohibited in certain jurisdictions. Participants are responsible for ensuring their participation is lawful where they reside. The project does not solicit participation from residents of any jurisdiction in which such solicitation would be unlawful.

No fiduciary duty

The community owes no fiduciary duty to participants. There is no contract between the community and any holder of \$GARY. The community provides this whitepaper, the website, and other materials on a strictly informational and as-is basis.

Anti-fraud and impersonation

Impersonation of the project, the community, the Foundation, or Mr. Sinise — including the deployment of copycat tokens, the spoofing of social accounts, or the publication of false statements — is unequivocally condemned by this community. Where possible, the community will report such conduct to the relevant platforms. Participants who become aware of such conduct are urged to do the same.
